

Finding Collingwood Environmental Planning ...

The Chandlery is a Victorian Board School building circa 1850 situated near Waterloo Station at 50 Westminster Bridge Road, between the junctions with St Georges Road and Waterloo Road. The office is well served by public transport and we encourage visitors to avoid using private cars.

Railway:

- the nearest mainline station is **London Waterloo**, five minutes walk away. London Waterloo serves south west London and the South West of England.
- **Waterloo East** provides services to south east London, Kent and East Sussex.

Exit the station on Waterloo Road or Station Approach heading in a south / south east direction.

Tube:

- **Lambeth North** (Bakerloo Line) is the nearest tube station.
- **Waterloo** a few minutes walk further away (Northern Line – Charing Cross branch, Jubilee Line, Bakerloo Line and Waterloo and City Line).

Buses:

- The area is on several bus routes.

To find our office: Enter The Chandlery via the pedestrian gate on Westminster Bridge Road (note this is not locked during office hours). Once within the courtyard, our office is accessed via the entry door to your left (near the cycle rack). There is an entry buzzer at this entrance (Unit 1E) and we are on the first floor. If you have problems finding our office within The Chandlery, there is a reception in the entrance straight ahead as you enter the courtyard.
